



Covid-19 Safety Rules For In-Person Instruction

Instructors

- Instructor will be expected to check his or her own health condition, temperature (<100.4F), chest pain, coughing, before leaving for a day of teaching at SSA.
- At arrival, instructor must use hand sanitizer or wash hands with soap and water for about 20 seconds.
- Instructor must wear a face mask or shield at all times.
- Instructor must observe a safety distance of 6ft or more to the students at all times.
- Tuning must be done by the student. Instructor can guide the student's tuning by telling, showing, or/and holding up a tuning app.
- Holding and posture details can only be shown from the distance. No hands-on correction by touching the student is allowed.
- If instructor becomes sick during work, he or she must stop teaching, send the student home and leave the facility.

Students

- Student's health condition must be checked on the day of the class: temperature <100.4F, no chest pain or coughing. Lesson must be canceled if the student is not well.
- Student must wear their own face mask or shield starting from before entering the facility.
- At arrival, student must use hand sanitizer.
- Student will not be allowed to use the restroom unless there is an emergency.
- Student must bring, use and leave with their own pencil and instruction book(s).

Parents

- Parents must check their child's temperature <100.4F, and their general health status the day of their class and send them to class only if the child is healthy.
- Parents might be asked by instructor to accompany their child to the lesson but only if the parent wears a face mask or shield and observes a safety distance of 6ft to instructor.
- If not asked by the instructor, parent should wait outside or in the car.
- No other person, like a guest, family member, friend, is allowed inside with the student.
